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## Learning Language is a Messy Process!



Course Description: This is an advanced intermediate course in Spanish language and culture that will build upon students' foundation to dive deeper into language and culture. Through COMPREHENSIBLE INPUT, which includes reading longer and more complex texts, story-telling, and listening, students will gain increasing confidence and skills with OUTPUT (speaking and writing). Since this is a Level IV class, most of the instruction will occur EN ESPAÑOL so it is critical that you attend class regularly. Get ready for IMMERSION to take your language skills to the next level. ¡Qué chevere! (How cool!!!)

## Classroom Norms \& Expectations:

1. Participation and attendance are SUPER important when learning a language.
2. Listen with the intent to understand and CONTRIBUTE
3. Habla español: Speak Spanish

## What will we do to get there?

1. We will speak a lot of Spanish!!-Class will be conducted in Spanish at least 98\% of the time.
2. We will read and listen to a lot of Spanish! - I will use a technique called Comprehensible Input - a research-based method that requires 'taking in' language (reading \& listening) with lots of repetitions. This will help your output (writing \& speaking). Yes, we will write too.

## What supplies do I need in Spanish Class to be successful?

## Required Supplies

*Please have with you every day:

- Pen or pencil
- Separate 3-ring binder with 5 sections (Calentamiento, Escribir, Vocabulario, Canciones, Gramática y Notas)
- Computer, charger and access to school gmail account
- Open mind, kind heart and willingness to take risks (3)

3. NO Google Translate! - There is a lot of technology out there but we will build skills independently of these. This means we will not use online translators. You can use online dictionaries or language learning programs / apps like:, www.wordreference.com , Duolingo, Babble, etc...
4. NO SIDE CONVERSATIONS! - Be present, participate and have fun. Cell phones are NOT allowed in class (unless otherwise instructed by your teacher)

This portion of your grade reflects how well your are learning the language \& ability to show 21st century skills.

Comprehension - How well you understand the language.

Communication - How well you communicate with others (this does not require perfection but the effort to understand and be understood)

21st Century skills - How well you collaborate, think critically and present refined work

## Español 4 Learning Targets

Reading and Listening:I can read and listen to high-intermediate texts, stories and novels in a variety of tenses, including perfect tenses, conditional, subjunctive moods.

Writing: I will also be able to write organized essays on various topics, using new vocabulary that I will acquire from our class activities and discussions.
